Cleaning and Health and Safety Protocols

Please be aware there is a general TCAL Kids Health and Safety Protocols that addresses the overall ministry protocols. This information will focus solely on the baby classrooms.

- All volunteers will wear a mask provided by TCAL at all times while serving
- Volunteers will wear gloves when providing care directly to a baby's face or body. They will wash hands often to ensure they are clean at all times.
- We will ask that you fill out a "Care Form" at drop off that will give you options about your baby's care.
- If you want to leave diapers, wipes, and/or bottle, we will ask that you place them in a provided ziploc and write your baby's name on bag.
- We will designate one volunteer in classroom to be the check-in volunteer to write on ziploc, and baby's name on dry erase board. We will only use one designated sharpie for this purpose for the designated volunteer. These are extra procedure we will take to ensure the safety of your baby.
- We will social distance the babies in the room from each other as much as possible.
- Toys have been limited in the classroom. We will have toys designed for each service to ensure they are sanitized appropriately.
- The classroom will be fogged in between services and after services so all hard and soft surfaces, as well as furniture will be sanitized. The solution is safe and dries immediately upon contact.
