

Preschool Classroom Cleaning and Health and Safety Protocols

Please be aware there is a general TCAL Kids Health and Safety Protocols that addresses the overall ministry protocols. This information will focus solely on the preschool classrooms.

- All volunteers will wear the mask provided by TCAL at all times while serving.
- All volunteers will wash hands often to ensure they are clean at all times. They will wear gloves if they need to provide care directly to a child's face or body.
- We will designate one volunteer to be the check-in volunteer to write child's name on clipboard attendance roster. We will use one designated sharpie for this purpose for the designated volunteer.
- Although we cannot expect preschoolers to social distance, we will space them out as much as possible while doing activities and will rotate them through planned games and crafts. Preschoolers will not leave the rooms and join with other classes at this time.
- All children will use separate supplies. Supplies will be minimal. We will ensure all used supplies are sanitized appropriately before they are used again.
- Toys have been limited in the classroom. Each service will have designed toys. All toys will be sanitized each week and after services as needed.
- The classroom will be fogged in between services and after services so all hard and soft surfaces, as well as furniture will be sanitized. The solution is safe and dries immediately upon contact.
